SUMMARY OF THE PROJECT

The Project focuses on adaptation and implementation of uniform biological indicators for assessment and control of environmental quality in the eastern part Gulf of Finland (GoF).

The development and harmonization of marine monitoring and environmental status assessment between countries sharing the same sub-regions are essential.

The project is directly linked to the ongoing work in HELCOM and is the national (Estonian and Russian) and sub-regional (GoF) contribution rather than duplication regard to the assessment of the impact of harmful substances.

Within the course of 35 months beneficiaries will organize the exchange of information regarding the evaluation of pressures, joint attempts to fill in gaps regarding Good Environmental Status descriptors and boundaries.
