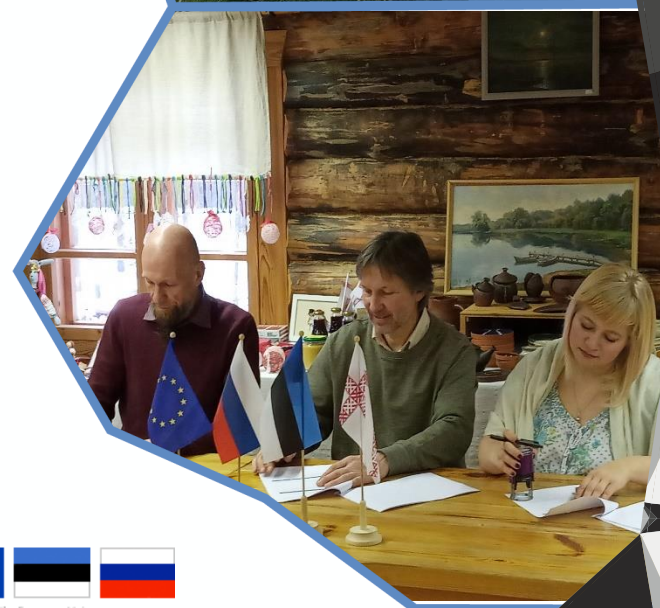

SUMMARY OF THE PROJECT

Active Village project aims to improve the development and competitiveness of rural SMEs and entrepreneurs by fostering cross border cooperation and product development in horticultural sector. The assortment and volume of farm products and processed local food products will be increased.

Modern infrastructure and equipment for product development and processing of primary farming products will be arranged for rural SMEs and gardeners from horticultural sector:

- Former pigsty will be renovated and converted into a freezing center in Obinitsa (Estonia);
- Innovative irrigation system will be installed in Röpina School of horticulture (Estonia);
- Center for drying and packaging of agricultural products will be built and equipped in Pskov (Russia).
