## SUMMARY OF THE PROJECT

SME ACCESS will support small and medium enterprises' development in Setomaa and Pechory district by promoting traditional business and improvement of road and marketplaces infrastructure.

Project activities include construction and equipping of market places in Värška village and in Pechory to support local SMEs' development and their products promotion. Also road infrastructure will be improved by reconstruction of roads, cycle and foot ways, and parking areas to refine business environment. Platform for young and experienced entrepreneurs will be set up to ensure experience exchange and explore new possibilities during workshops, study-tours, seminars and local fairs.
