## SUMMARY OF THE PROJECT

"Heritage Teaching" aims to improve cooperation between municipal authorities and communities in introducing old traditions, customs and language at the schools locating in historical Setomaa territory in order to preserve and promote local cultural and historical heritage.

Project activities include celebration of religious and traditional holidays, obtaining knowledge about food and handicraft traditions, old games, singing (seto leelo) and dancing traditions. Also training of teachers, study visits, camps, needed equipment and materials for teaching practical skills in music, handicraft are foreseen during the project.

Additionally attractive heritage teaching program for 2 school grades will be created for applying in Setomaa schools to increase children's motivation to preserve local heritage culture and stronger identity.
